BRICKOLLAGING

Create a piece of art by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a small rectangular block typically made of fired or sundried clay, used in building.

SNAILCOMMUTING

Travel some distance between one's home and place of work on a mollusc with a single spiral shell into which the whole body can be withdrawn on a regular basis.

DEVICEWORSHIPPING

Show reverence and adoration for a thing made or adapted for a particular purpose, especially a piece of mechanical or electronic equipment.

MEMORYHATING

Feel intense dislike for the way the mind stores and remembers information.

COSMETICBREXITING

The potential or hypothetical departure of the United Kingdom from the European Union intended to restore or improve its appearance.

CAGETHINKING

A structure of bars or wires into which the process of considering or reasoning about something is confined.

NEWSEATING

Put newly received or noteworthy information into the mouth and chew and swallow especially recent events.

SHARDBUILDING

The action or trade of constructing pieces of broken ceramic, metal, glass, or rock, typically having sharp edges.

PLASTERRORISING

Create and maintain a state of extreme fear and distress in a soft mixture of sand and cement and sometimes lime with water; fill with terror to form a smooth hard surface when dried.

BOOKGESTICULATING

To make lively or energetic motions with a written or printed work consisting of pages glued or sewn together along one side and bound in covers.

SUGARFEARING

Be afraid of a sweet crystalline substance obtained from various plants as likely to be dangerous, painful, or harmful when used as a sweetener in food and drink.

CLOCKDANCING

Move to the rhythm of a mechanical or electrical device for measuring time, typically following a set sequence of steps indicating hours, minutes, and sometimes seconds.

LIGHTSACRIFICING

Give up the natural agent that stimulates sight and makes things visible for the sake of other considerations.

EGGLYING

An oval or round object laid by a female bird, reptile, fish, or invertebrate, saying something untrue about containing a developing embryo.

MOSSFEELING

Experience the sensation of a small flowerless green plant which lacks true roots, through touching or being touched.

BODYTRAVELLING

Make a journey along a physical structure or through the bones, flesh, and organs, of a person or an animal.

DEATHCELEBRATING

Acknowledge the permanent cessation of the vital functions of a person, animal, plant, or other organism with a social gathering or enjoyable activity.

PEBBLESINGING

Make smooth and round musical sounds with the action of water or sand on a small stone with a set tune.

CERAMICREADING

The ability to look at and comprehend the meaning of pieces made of clay and permanently hardened by heat.

DREAMFRAMING

Place a series of thoughts, images, and sensations in a rigid structure that surrounds a person's mind during sleep.

CANDYFIGHTING

Impart knowledge to or instruct (someone) as to how to make a hot drink by infusing the dried crushed leaves of the tea plant in boiling water.

MARBLELOVEMAKING
